IMPRESSIVE START FIELD AT BMW DRAGON GOLD Cup IN MARSTRAND AUGUST 4 TO 13th.

Sailors from around the world meet at Marstrand to compete in BMW Dragon Gold Cup. Total notified Dragons are an impressive 102 boats. In addition to the many participants from the Nordic countries the most remarkable is the high number of participants from Russia.

"It will be fun and very tough on the starting line says Peter Kolni (GKSS), who recently with his crew onboard SWE328 came 2nd in the Swedish Championship for Dragons. Among the 102 participating there are well about 20 names that can be counted as potential winners of the BMW Dragon Gold Cup believe Peter. Difficult to name any specific names, but Denmark, England, Ireland, Russia and Germany have many good sailors, "concludes Peter Kolni.

Large starting fields is not extraordinary in the Dragon Class, but in the Dragon Gold Cup race there was long ago the number of boats exceeded 100 boats.

"The limit for participating boats in the Dragon Gold Cup is on 120 boats," said Kerstin Holmberg, Chairman of the Race Committee for BMW Dragon Gold Cup. This exceeds all our expectations ".

Between 50-60 volunteers will work during the race week to make the conditions for the race ant the participants. The race begins with "Tune-up race" on Saturday August 8th and ends with a roaring Regatta party at "Socitetshuset" August 12th, where both the Swedish and the Danish royal families are expected.
