### **1. Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.3 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### **2. Eligibility requirements**

- 2.1 All competitors sailing ISAF Grade 3 shall obtain an ISAF Sailor ID by registering online at [www.sailing.org/isafsailor](http://www.sailing.org/isafsailor). Skippers shall inform the OA of their ISAF Sailor ID at registration.
- 2.2 The person in charge onboard the boat shall be a member of his/her Member National Authority or one of its affiliated organisations.
- 2.3 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.

- 2.4 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 2.5 If there are less than 5 entries in a class by 26<sup>th</sup> April, the OA may cancel the class from the regatta. For 470 the total number of entries, men and women must be at least 5.

### 3. Entries

- 3.1 The entry fee before 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2011 is SEK 400 for a single handed boat and SEK 600 for a double handed boat.
- 3.2 Advance entry shall be made not later than 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2011 at the GKSS website [www.gkss.se](http://www.gkss.se). After that date and until 6<sup>th</sup> May at 21.00 hours, fee will be increased by 50%.

### 4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registration shall be made at the race office not later than 7<sup>th</sup> May 2011, at 08.00 hours.
- 4.2 A Helmsman declaration is available on GKSS Website and should be signed at the race office at registration.
- 4.3 Measurement checks will be performed at the OAs discretion.

### 5. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available after registration.

## **10. Scoring**

The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

## **11. Prizes**

GKSS' prizes according to the number of boats entered: one prize for every five boats or part of five with a maximum of eight prizes per class. Prize winners who have not collected for their prizes at the Secretariat of GKSS the week number 25, 2011 will lose their right to the prizes.
